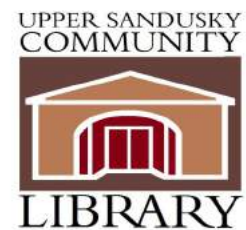

Pat Riedel's Baked Cabbage

Cook cored and sliced cabbage in salted water until tender (about 25-30 minutes). Make a white sauce of 3 Tablespoons of butter, 3 Tablespoons of flour, and 1 and 3/4 cups of milk. Layer half of cooked cabbage in a casserole dish, then top with 1 sleeve of crushed saltine crackers and 1 cup of shredded cheddar cheese. Repeat layers, ending with cheese. Bake at 350 degrees for 30 minutes.




