## Pat Riedel's Rhubarb Cake

- 2 cups sugar
- 1/2 cup shortening
- 1 egg
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 2 cups flour
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup sour milk or buttermilk
- 2 cups rhubarb, chopped and floured
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 1 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1/4 cup butter

Cream 1 1/2 cups of the sugar and shortening. Add egg. Add dry ingredients alternately with milk. Add rhubarb and vanilla. Transfer mixture to a greased 9X13 pan. Mix remaining ingredients until crumbly and sprinkle on top. Bake at 350° for 35-45 minutes.



## Joyce Walton's Tater Tot Casserole

- 2 lbs. frozen tater tots or hash browns
- 1/2 cup butter, melted
- 1 (10 oz.) can cream of chicken soup
- 1 pint sour cream
- 1/2 cup chopped onions
- 2 cups shredded cheddar cheese, divided
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper

In a large bowl, combine the butter, soup, sour cream, onion, 1 1/2 cups shredded cheddar cheese, salt and pepper. Mix well, then add the tater tots or hash browns and mix gently. Place in a greased 9x13 casserole dish and bake at 350° for 45 minutes. Sprinkle the remaining 1/2 cup of shredded cheese over the top of the casserole and bake 5 more minutes.
